Harrie Samaras Becomes a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators

West Chester, Pa. – On April 21, 2010, Harrie Samaras was admitted as a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (CI Arb). There are only about 300 Fellows of the Chartered Institute in the world.

The CI Arb is a not-for-profit organization that exists for the global promotion, facilitation and development of all forms of private dispute resolution to maximize the contribution that dispute resolution practitioners make. Among other things it provides education and training for arbitrators and mediators.

Harrie obtained Fellow status with the CI Arb taking its accelerated route to Fellowship. This program is for individuals who are qualified lawyers and have already acquired a substantial knowledge of arbitration. It involves attending a 2-day workshop that assesses candidates' legal knowledge and practical know-how and skill in conducting the arbitration process. After successful completion of this assessment, candidates are required to complete CI Arb's Module 4 (Award Writing) and a peer interview. The program emphasizes proficiency in the UNCITRAL Rules.

The Chartered Institute is based in London, England but it has a global membership of around 12,000 individuals who have professional training in private dispute resolution.
