Harrie Samaras Moderates Panel on International Arbitration

West Chester, Pa. – Harrie Samaras moderated a panel of international arbitration experts on May 20, 2011 as part of a one-day program sponsored by the American Bar Association’s Section of International Law and the Los Angeles County Bar Association’s International Law Section. The program was entitled: *International Arbitration in the 21st Century: Trends, Developments, Challenges*.

The panel of experts discussed recent changes to the United Nations Commission on International Trade Law (UNCITRAL) Rules of Arbitration and the International Bar Association’s (IBA) Rules of Evidence, as well as anticipated changes to the International Chamber of Commerce (ICC) Rules of Arbitration. Harrie also led an interactive discussion between panel members and the audience on the practical implications of the rule changes.
